In Maths, we have been comparing objects and numbers using comparison signs! Our teachers have been so impressed with our understanding of key terms! We also enjoyed our COJO mission where we built our resilience and teamwork. Next week, we will continue to use our writing toolkit to build sentences and begin to add numbers to 10!

Year 2

Year 2 have been reading and using our phonics knowledge and planning a diary entry. In maths, we have been practising counting in 2s, 5s, and 10s. Next week, we will be starting on a new topic of addition and subtraction. In foundation subjects we have been learning the 4 countries that make up the UK.

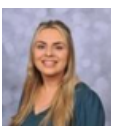

Year 3

What a brilliant week we have had in Year 3 this week. In Literacy we have completed our first hot write and moved onto our new style of text (instructions) using our new text 'How to trap a troll'. In Maths, we have been comparing numbers to 1000, getting ready to move onto our new topic of addition and subtraction. We have also loved discussing what a plant needs to grow in Science and we have set up an investigation how we can prove this. We have planted some seeds and gave them a different environment to grow.

Year 4

A fantastic week in Year 4! We have displayed outstanding writing in our Adventure Narrative Hotwrites. We have also began our next Maths topic 'addition and subtraction' in which we have showed determination using the column method. We have had a lovely treat from 'skipping school', learning new skipping tricks in preparation for the Skipping Festival. We have also researched the diets of Ancient Greeks and even created our own ideal Greek Menu! Well Done Year 4!

Year 5

In Literacy this week, Year 5 have been exploring persuasive texts using Greek mythology, such as Zeus and Prometheus. In Maths this week, we have started our topic of addition and subtraction where we have been working hard to ensure we can confidently exchange. In guided reading we have been reading a series of persuasive letters written from the point of view of a naughty dog at the kennels!

Year 6

Year 6 have worked really hard this week! In Maths, we have been working up to 4 digits x 2 digits multiplication. Whilst in Literacy, we have been focusing on list poems and analysing our text 'The Cave of Curiosity'. We have even had a go at writing our own list poem called 'The Realm of Wonder'. In guided reading we have been reading an extract from Harry Potter and the Philosopher's stone! Next week, we will be focusing on short and long division, as well as innovating our text.
