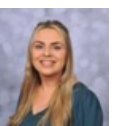

## Weekly Newsletter

### Year 3

In Literacy this week, Year 3 have enjoyed learning, performing, innovating and inventing a range of poetry. We have focused on using verses, repetition and rhyming. In Maths, we have completed our unit of work on length and perimeter and are now looking at fractions. Year 3 have also particularly enjoyed their PSHE lesson this week which was delivered by a visitor from 'Connect' and focused on Friendships. Finally, we are super excited for our Trip next week to the Centre for Life.

### Year 4

In Maths this week, we have been focusing on our new topic of decimals, dividing one and two digit numbers by 10 using a decimal point. In Literacy this week, we have focused on bias and perspective to upskill our 'Hot Writes' and started our new topic of a Diary entry. We have looked at different states of matter in science, looking at different objects and their 'state'. In RE, we have compared different artwork of the Last Supper, looking at similarities and differences.

### Year 5

In Year 5 this week, Children have continued their fractions, decimals and percentages unit, finding the equivalent amount and attacking a range of Problem Solving skills. Children are enjoying the start they have made to their Newspaper Reports, writing about a fictional missing character from a Lake in Minnesota. In DT, children have impressed with their skills to design, paint and create a Lunar Moon Buggy.

### Year 6

In Year 6, we have started revising areas from the Math's curriculum - place value, fractions and addition and subtraction. In Literacy, we have begun innovating our non-chronological reports. We will be focusing on vampires and their origins. In RE, we have recapped the Easter Story and Jesus' resurrection. Lastly, the children have been enjoying playing rounders and hockey.
