### The Den/ Nursery

Bold Bunnies have been exploring light and dark this week. We celebrated the Festival of Light and Bonfire Night and created sparkles in the sky in our studio.

Red Squirrels have explored the story of Brown Bear, Brown Bear, what do you see? We have started to explore our senses looking at what we can see through nature walks and magnifying glass activities. We have discussed what Remembrance Day is and started some poppy craft.

### Reception

This week, Reception read the story 'Funny Bones' by Janet and Alan Ahlberg. In the Theater we investigated different methods of 'fixing things' and putting bones back together. In the studio we explored line art, focussing on the shapes we see in a spider's web. In maths, we looked at individual parts which can make a whole object. Just like the parts of our body make the whole of us. In woodlands, we discussed Bonfire Night and fire safety, then practised by making our own 'bonfire'.

### Year 1

This week in Literacy we have been focusing on 'Fred Talking' and blending green from our focus story and spotting red words in a piece of small text. In Maths, we are learning our number bonds and we are developing our confidence when using part whole models! Science has been just as fun, we have begun to learn about the human body!

We have had a great first week back!

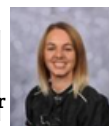
### Year 2

## Weekly Newsletter

### Year 3

In Year 3 this week, we have continued our Maths topic of addition and subtraction learning how to add and subtract with exchange. In Literacy we have began our new unit using the story 'The Stone Age Boy'. The children have enjoyed learning what life was like in the Stone Age. In Science, we have started learning about nutrition and the 5 main food groups and how we can use this to have a balanced diet. In Spanish this term we will be learning the names of animals. What a great first week back!

### Year 4

In Year 4 this week, we have continued our Math topic of length and perimeter and completed our post assessment. The children have really enjoyed our new literacy topic 'a tale of fear.' We have talked about some of our fears and how we could overcome them. The children loved hearing their teachers fears! During our RE lesson this week, we have had a recap of the Christmas story before our preparations for our Christmas performance. It has been such a lovely first week back at school. Well done Year 4!

### Year 5

This week in year 5 we have started to explore multiplication and division in maths. To begin, the children have experimented with factor bugs, multiples and prime numbers. In literacy, we have started a new topic centred around quests. To help us with this, we have used "Jason and the Golden Fleece" as our model text. Both classes have also started to read "There's a boy in the girls' toilet", which all children have enjoyed.

### Year 6

This week in Year 6 we have been finding missing angles in quadrilaterals and polygons. There has been an impressive display of resilience when drawing regular and irregular polygons with a protractor. In Literacy, we have been learning about the correct use of semi-colons and have began our new Talk4Writing text: Macbeth. Both Year 6 classes have started reading 'Holes' by Louis Sachar.
