We have also started our new DT topic - puppets which we are very excited about! We can't wait to make our own puppets!

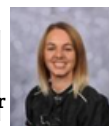
Year 2

In Maths this week, we have focused on adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominator and subtracting from a whole number. In Year 5 this week we have innovated a wishing tale, exploring the use of figurative language. In maths we have been adding, subtracting and multiplying fractions. Children are also progressing well with their weekly cycling rides, visiting the Rising Sun and the Sun dial.

Year 6

In Year 6, we have completed a maths unit on work on Position and Direction. We are moving onto Algebra focussing algebraic expressions and equations.
