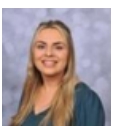

### Year 3

In Year 3, this week we have begun to conclude our topic of addition and subtraction in Maths, ending on estimation and compliments to 100. In Literacy Year 3 have developed our ability to use metaphors within our writing while continuing to use The Stone Age Boy as our text. In Science, we have introduced a new topic of Animals including Humans where we have looked at nutrition. We have thoroughly enjoyed making pottery - relating to the stone age with our visitors from Segendunum.

### Year 4

In Year 4 this week, we have continued our Math topic of length and perimeter and completed our post assessment. The children have really enjoyed our new literacy topic 'a tale of fear.' We have talked about some of our fears and how we could overcome them. The children loved hearing their teachers fears! During our RE lesson this week, we have had a recap of the Christmas story before our preparations for our Christmas performance. It has been such a lovely first week back at school. Well done Year 4!

### Year 5

This week in year 5 we have continued to explore multiplication and division in maths. Developing their understanding of square and cubed numbers. In literacy, children have innovated "Jason and the Golden Fleece" and produced some wonderful pieces of writing. Children have also engaged in Anti-Bullying week and generated some wonderful discussions as part of this.

### Year 6

This week in Year 6 we finished our unit of work on Shape. The children have really improved their knowledge in this topic - well done! Our next topic is fractions, which is quite a lengthy unit of work. In Literacy, we are continuing to develop the children's knowledge on playscripts using William Shakespeare's 'Macbeth'. As well as playscripts, children have been improving their character description through the use of 'outside, inside' sentences and semicolons.
