Our youngest learners have especially enjoyed mixing paint to create colourful Autumn shades. Red Squirrels have shared their love for Autumn, we have explored autumnal colours and natural materials through messy play, creative activities, physical outdoor activities and cutting and printing with various vegetables.

Reception

In the Theater we practised the skill of puppeteering, with leafy family puppets. In the Studio we focussed on leaf printing with Autumnal colours. In maths, Reception have compared amounts within 5, using the vocabulary; more / less / equal. In PE, we developed our ball skills, by rolling with our hands.

Meanwhile, in class we have been focusing on writing sentences and remembering to include our writing features and phonetic sounds. 1A have been consolidating their knowledge of ordering numbers from greatest to smallest in Maths and 1B have been focusing on addition using part whole models. We also had lots of fun at our Halloween disco... we looked spook-tacular!

Year 2

We were amazed at how brilliant Year 2 were in their Harvest Festival Performance. Big well done and thank you for all your donations! In Maths this week we have been introduced to addition and subtraction and the children have been learning about fact families, related facts and number bonds to 10 and 100. In Literacy, they have been building sentences independently using all of our toolkit features. Well done!

This week in Literacy we are closing our unit of work on instructions and finalising our plans and invent texts. In Maths we have been adding one, tens and hundred to three digit numbers and have even begun to cross the tens!

Year 4

In Year 4 Literacy this week, we have focused on Non Chronological reports, researching appropriate subheadings and what research we would like to include. In Maths this week, we have been focusing on the inverse and using the commutative law within fact families to support us. In science, we have been learning about our digestive system. We were also looking at climate change in Geography, and followed hurricane Milton in Florida!

Year 5

In Literacy this week, Year 5 have explored Cinquains poetry, ensuring each line has the correct amount of syllables, writing about different monsters and chocolate!
