Next week, we will be continuing to explore our text 'Oi Frog' and write our own rhyming poems!

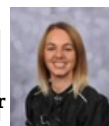
Year 2

Year 3

This week in Year 3, we have innovated our wishing tale using fantastic expanded noun phrases. In Mathematics, children have continued our Place Value topic learning how to partition numbers to 1000. Children have enjoyed learning about Spain. Children are enjoying our Geography topic learning about Europe and we have learnt which countries make up Europe. In PE, we have started dribbling in Hockey and learning how to stop the ball.

Year 4

This week in Year 4, children have continued to develop their adventure story writing by looking at how to use expanded noun phrases and 'show don't tell' to make their writing more engaging. In Maths, we have been rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000 as well as developing our knowledge of Roman numerals and negative numbers. In Science, we are investigating teeth and in Geography, we have started our topic on rivers.

Year 5

This week in Year 5, children have completed their 'Defeating a Monster' narrative and have produced some brilliant Hot Writes. In Mathematics, children have continued their Place Value topic with a focus on rounding numbers up to 1,000,000. Children are enjoying our History and Geography topics, which focus on The Vikings and where they settled in Britain. In PE, children are developing their Football skills as well as their dancing techniques.

Year 6

This week in Year 6, children are innovating their suspense tales and have produced excellent writing. In Mathematics, children have completed their Place Value topic and are now focusing on the Four Operations. Children are enjoying our History and Geography topics, focusing on different women in history. In PE, children are developing their ball skills, specifically with a focus of sending and receiving.
