The Den/ Nursery

We have enjoyed reading a non-fiction book in the Den this week. We have talked about all about the different insects that live in our garden and we went on an adventure to find as many as we could. We were so excited to find Wiggly Woo! On Tasty Tuesday, we rolled dough into wiggly worm breadsticks and dipped them in garlic and tomato salsa. We can't wait until next week to see if any pixies and elves have visited our fairy garden.

In Nursery, we have enjoyed immersing our learning in the wonders of spring, learning about the growth of animals and beginning to explore what animals and plants need to live. We explored a range of different materials and created ducklings using feathers, playdough, paint and pipe cleaners. During Woodland Wednesday, we collected natural materials to make birds nests.

Reception

This week Reception have began to investigate changes in the weather as we enter early spring. We read the text 'Rain Before Rainbows' and were inspired to create our own weather wheels in the theatre. In the studio we've used drip art to form rainbow-like patterns.

In PE, we've started developing new gymnastics skills and have been practising our jumping and landing skills on the apparatus.

Year 1

In Maths this week, we have been comparing the mass, volume and capacity of objects and have enjoyed exploring this with a variety of objects in our classroom!

In Literacy, we have been writing some fantastic descriptive sentences about what is in the Magic Box. Our teachers were amazed!

We have also enjoyed our Science lessons where we are investigating the properties of materials.

Year 2

In Literacy, we have been writing some brilliant acrostic poems. We have been trying to include all the toolkit features including similes, alliteration and onomatopoeia.

In Maths, we have been counting money, making the same amount of money and comparing amounts of money. We have worked so hard!

In Science, we have been measuring our plants with rulers to see how tall they are.

Year 6

In Year 6, we have completed our unit on Algebra and are moving on to statistics. The children worked very hard to improve their knowledge in Algebra - well done! In Literacy, the children have finished their biographies and we will be moving onto non-chronological reports. Lastly, children have started a science unit of light and have learnt about light sources and that light travels in straight lines.
