### Year 1

This week we in Literacy we have been applying our knowledge of verbs and adjectives to use them in sentences. In Maths, we have been using the number line to find one more and one less of numbers to 20.

### Year 2

In Literacy this week we have been writing character descriptions including our toolkit features. We have learnt about similes and have been including these in our writing.

In Maths, we have started looking at our 2,5,10 and 3 times table. We have also been looking at making equal groups with counters. Well done Year 2!

## Weekly Newsletter

### Year 3

This week in Year 3, we've had a fantastic time using drama to bring our discussions and debates to life! By acting out different perspectives, we've been able to innovate and create our own discussion texts. One of our favorite debates was discussing whether school uniform should be banned, where we shared and challenged different viewpoints. In Maths, we've been building on our counting skills by practicing counting in 2s, 4s, and 8s and applying this to expand our knowledge of different timestables.

### Year 4

This week in Year 4, we have completed our hot writes for our warning tales unit. We have been incredibly impressed with the standard of writing as the children have included a wide range of features including show don't tell and expanded noun phrases. In Maths, we have been continuing our work on division, including with remainders and have been learning how to solve scaling and correspondence problems using multiplication and division. In History, we have started our new unit on The Romans and in Geography, we have been following the course of the Tyne River on Google Earth to identify its features and looked at what causes flooding and what we can do to prevent it.

### Year 5

Year 5 children have had a challenging week, exploring Column Multiplication in Mathematics, where they have shown an incredible amount of resilience to develop their skills within this. Children have also come to the end of their Non-chronological unit in Literacy, producing brilliant hot writes on an animal from Southern America, which they researched prior. Children are enjoying their tennis lessons in PE, creating different rallies and improving their technique.

### Year 6

In Year 6, we have been improving our knowledge on fractions, decimals and percentages by finding percentages of amounts and finding equivalence. In Literacy, we have been continuing our 'Warning Tales'. We have been innovating this week which means we have changed the characters and setting but kept the main elements of a warning tale. We have been very impressed with the children's use of vocabulary in their writing, well done!
