Year 3

This week in Literacy, Year 3 have been innovating and inventing their own wishing tales based on their class text Billy Goats Gruff. They have also focused on inverted commas and conjunctions which they have applied in their writing. In Maths we have been looking at 1, 10 and 100 more and less than numbers up to 1000. Year 3 have also enjoyed continuing to explore the artist Pablo Picasso and looked at the effects of warm and cool colours in art.

Year 4

This week in Year 4, in Literacy lessons the children have been innovating their adventure narrative, ready for their hotwrite next week. In Maths lessons we have focused on Roman Numerals to 100, we have loved looking at football cards to challenge if we can change their skills from numbers to Roman Numerals. The children have also enjoyed focusing on the artist Monet during Art lessons and researching Judaism in RE lessons. We have saw lots of determination to achieve pen licences this week!

Year 5

This week in Year 5, children have started their persuasive writing in Literacy, exploring the Ancient Greek myth of Pandora's box and have analysed the toolkit features within this. In Mathematics, children have come to an end of their Place Value topic and look forward to starting 'Addition and Subtraction' next week. Children have also enjoyed their scientific enquires and enjoyed the investigations involving the absorbency of specific materials.

Year 6

This week in Year 6, children have completed a mock SAT week. We are very proud of them and they handled the week extremely well. In Mathematics, children are continuing their work on the four operations - addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Children have also enjoyed their scientific enquires and are learning about microorganisms. In Literacy, children finished their suspense tale and are moving on to list poetry.
