Reception

In the studio we have been carving clay. In the theatre we have used natural resources to create nature crowns. In PE we learnt how to do a forward roll. In maths we have re-visited 2D and 3D shapes. We have used them to create repeated patterns.

Year 1

What a wonderful first week of Spring! We have had fun in Literacy practising our writing skills about what is in our 'Magic Box' and writing this in a descriptive poetic format. In Maths, we have begun to learn our numbers to 50 and how to efficiently count up to a larger number; and then in Science we have been inquisitive scientists testing materials for different purposes and evaluating our methods!

Year 2

In Literacy we have been learning our new text 'The Day the Crayons Quit' and have been creating actions to help us remember. We are going to begin to look at persuasive writing. In Maths, we have been comparing money, adding amounts of money and learning about change. The children have been brilliant. In Science, we have been observing our plant grow each week and measuring this in cm.

Year 3

Year 3 have created their final pieces of Non-chronological report writing and moved onto the next topic in Literacy- Poetry. They have enjoyed beginning to learn and perform different poems. In Maths, they have been working hard to develop their knowledge of length and perimeter. Children have been comparing, converting adding and subtracting a range of different lengths in mm, cm and meters.

Year 4

Year 4 have completed their Hot write based off a Newspaper report. We had lots of brilliant 'breaking news' reports. In Maths this week, we have started our new unit of decimals and using a numberline to place tenths.

In PE we have enjoyed a few of our lessons outside in the lovely sunshine and even had a mixed Year 4A/B lesson. We have also enjoying creating lots of artwork this week.

Year 5

Year 5 have started their new topic in Literacy, exploring Newspaper Reports, which has focused on Reported and Direct speech, as well as Formal Writing. Children have also started their new Unit in Maths, which uses their understanding of Fractions to compare to different decimals. Children are enjoying our Science Unit, exploring Space and the Earth's movement relative to the sun.

Year 6

This week in Year 6, we have started an exciting new unit in Literacy all about non-chronological reports. Our focus will be on fascinating mythological creatures, and we'll be using our research skills to gather interesting facts before writing our own detailed reports. So, get your thinking caps on and dive into the world of dragons, griffins and more! In Maths, we have now completed our work on algebra and statistics. The children have worked incredibly hard and shown great perseverance with some tricky concepts. Next, we'll begin our revision journey to prepare for the upcoming assessments, revisiting key topics and building confidence along the way.
