## Language & Communication Support



### Language and Communication Team

Specialist teachers and support assistants offer assessments, one-to-one interventions, strategy guidance, and training for staff, schools, and parents (e.g., Autism parent course, EYCOT for early years). Education Services

### Early Years Communication Outreach Team (EYCOT)

Targeted, nursery-based support for young children with speech and language difficulties, working directly with families and settings.




## Mental Health & Emotional Wellbeing
